Clinic Terms And Conditions

1. **Clinic cancellations will be handled by the clinic refund policy (Below).**
2. Event entry purchases made via the AGA Parent Portal are for the exact event only; and if not used may not be transferred to any other purchase (including tuition)
3. Prior to being allowed to participate in the Clinic, the participants parent or legal guardian must accept the all terms and conditions located in the AGA Parent Portal.
4. If a child does not adhere to the rules of the clinic (either written or verbally provided), the parent may be called to pick them up. No refund will be offered if a child is sent home for disciplinary reasons.
5. You must come inside to sign your child in and out of the event.
6. Children attempting to check-in without an adult will not be allowed to participate and we will call you to come back before they are allowed to do so.
7. You must come in to sign out your child. ***Children will not be allowed to leave the building because “you are parked outside”.***

Clinic Payment:

- Final payment for any clinic entry is payable upon registration.

Clinic Refund Policy

- Due to the timelines and number of available entries associated with clinic reservations (typically within two weeks, and we limit the number of entries) once reserved, clinic payments are non-refundable and non-transferable for any reason.
- Additionally, No refund will be offered if a child is sent home for disciplinary reasons.

Clinic Schedule:

- The event schedule start/end times will show on the Parent Portal registration page.
- Additional fees will apply if a child is not picked up at the end of the event.
- If you are more than 20 minutes late picking up your child after the close of the event, and if we have not heard from you or been able to contact you, the appropriate authorities will be notified to assist us in caring for your child until you can be located.

Note: If your child brings one of these items and you are not still here where they can give it to you, they will have to put it in one of the lockers which are not secured. AGA will not be held responsible for the loss of any items:

- Jewelry
 - Stud earrings are ok, however hoop or any earring that dangles must be removed.
 - Bracelets of any type (including cloth/string bracelets), or rings, anklets, necklaces, etc. are not permitted.

Dress Code For Clinic:

- All clinic attendees must wear a one-piece bikini cut or unitard style gymnastics leotard. Leotards may be of any color/s.
- Dance leotards (leotards with skirts and/or stockings), jeans, jean shorts, footed tights, sweat pants, sports bra/shorts, or items with zippers or buttons are not allowed as these are unsafe for your gymnast and our instructors.
- Hair must be secured away from the face. If your child's hair can interfere with their vision, it needs to be pulled back in either a pony tail or bun.
