PNO Terms And Conditions

- **PNO reservation cancellations will be handled by the PNO refund policy (Below).**
- Event entry purchases made via the AGA Parent Portal are for the exact event only; and if not used may not be transferred to any other purchase (including tuition)
- Prior to being allowed to participate in the PNO, the participants parent or legal guardian must accept the all terms and conditions located in the AGA Parent Portal.
- If a child does not adhere to the rules of the PNO (either written or verbally provided), the parent may be called to pick them up.
- Children participating in the PNO must be between the ages of 5 and 16 years old.
- You must come inside to sign your child in and out of the event
- Children attempting to check-in without an adult will not be allowed to participate and we will call you to come back before they are allowed to do so.
- You must come in to sign out your child. ***Children will not be allowed to leave the building because "you are parked outside".***

PNO Payment:

- Final payment for any PNO entry is payable upon registration

PNO Refund Policy

- Due to the timelines and number of available entries associated with PNO reservations (typically within two weeks, and we limit the number of entries) once purchased, PNO entry fees are non-refundable and non-transferable for any reason.
- Additionally, No refund will be offered if a child is sent home for disciplinary reasons.

PNO Schedule:

- The event schedule start/end times will show on the Parent Portal registration page.
- Additional fees will apply if a child is not picked up at the end of the event.
- If you are more than 20 minutes late picking up your child after the close of the event, and if we have not heard from you or been able to contact you, the appropriate authorities will be notified to assist us in caring for your child until you can be located.

Things to Bring To PNO:

- No required items
- However, if a child has significant food allergies and/or is extremely picky regarding their food, you are more than welcome to send them with their own pre-prepared food and we will place it in the refrigerator for them and will give it to them during food time.

Please do NOT send your child with:

Note: If your child brings one of these items and you are not still here where they can give it to you, they will have to put it in one of the lockers which are not secured. AGA will not be held responsible for the loss of any items:

- Cell Phones/iPad/iPod or similar devices
- Cash
- Toys/Stuffed Animals
- Jewelry
 - Stud earrings are ok, however hoop or any earring that dangles must be removed.
 - Bracelets of any type (including cloth/string bracelets), or rings, anklets, necklaces, etc. are not permitted.

Dress Code For PNO:

- Girl and Boy participants should be in athletic attire at a minimum. Girls may wear a gymnastics leotard if desired.
- Dance leotards (leotards with skirts and/or stockings), jeans, jean shorts, footed tights, or items with zippers or buttons are not allowed as these are unsafe for your gymnast and our instructors.
- Hair must be secured away from the face. If your child's hair can interfere with their vision, it needs to be pulled back in either a pony tail or bun.
